Reminders

- Be sure to first obtain prior approval from Hellman Management before making any electrical or plumbing alterations that can affect other units. Please use the renovation form found on our website.
- Don't get slapped with a parking violation this winter! Do not park in snow removal areas. Vehicles parked in these designated areas during a snow fall will be towed at the owner's expense. Park within marked lines, and please obtain a new parking vehicle sticker if you have not already done so by filling out the parking form found on our website.
- Do not use your toilet as a wastebasket. Do not flush facial tissue, cotton balls, make-up pads, sanitary products or diapers, or

"flushable" wipes, as they do not dissolve and can clog the lines. Also, dental floss is notorious for clogging a toilet. Because the floss is so light weight, it doesn't always completely flush and accumulates in our lines and gets tangled over time. Always put used dental floss in the trash can. Keep a trash container in the bathroom and toss these items away.
